MSX Controller Setup

When the MSX controller is plugged in, the LCD screen on the control box will display the information from the previous game or the last information that was on the scoreboard when the controller was unplugged.

It will be necessary to "clear" the scoreboard and reset the controller for a new game. To do this, press "FUNCTION" then "1" then "ENTER"

Setting up MSX Controller defaults

After Powering up Controller. Depress Restore LCD button then Function button. The screen will show: **Sport:**

- 1. New Game
- 2. 2. Restart
- 3. Select Sport
- 4. Modify Score Rules

Depress 3 Enter Then 0 Enter.

There are a series of questions where the parameters need to be set. Questions are as follows under the following header:

Modify Scoring Rule: -----

Question #1 **Debug = 0, ASCII = 1 out**

Current = 0

Then Hit Next button

Question #2 Snap+Game = 1, SEP = 0

Current = 0

This allows snap clocks to run separate from

Game clock.

Then Hit Next button

Question #3 Radio = 1, Cable = 0

Current = 0

This is for cable hookup. If you have a wireless system the **Current** setting needs to be **1**.

Then Hit **Next** button

Question #4 Flash Home Score #:

1 = will Flash Home Score

0 = Normal Operation

Current = 0

Then Restore LCD button Select Sport

Then **New Game 1 Enter.** This should get the **LCD** screen to look Like the scoreboard.

Setting Basketball Parameters

After Powering up Controller. Depress Restore LCD button then Function button. The screen will show: **Sport:**

- 1. New Game 2. Restart
- 3. Select Sport
- 4. Modify Score Rules

Depress #3 Enter --- (Select Sport)
Depress #2 Enter --- (Basketball)
Depress #4 Enter --- (Modify Score Rules)

Next is a series of 12 questions: the LCD screen should look as follows

Inputting Player Fouls

Home Player No. – Enter the numbers from the keypad, press **Player Number**.

To clear to 0, press Player Number again, to clear to blank press Reset then Player Number. Or just enter the next number and press Player Number.

Home Player Foul – Enter the numbers from the keypad, press **Player Foul**.

To clear to 0, press Player Foul again, to clear to blank press Reset then Player Foul. Or just enter the next number and press Player Foul.

Visitor Player No. – Enter the numbers from the keypad, press **Player Number**.

To clear to 0, press Player Number again, to clear to blank press Reset then Player Number. Or just enter the next number and press Player Number.

Visitor Player Foul – Enter the numbers from the keypad, press **Player Foul**.

To clear to 0, press Player Foul again, to clear to blank press Reset then Player Foul. Or just enter the next number and press Player Foul.

- **Home Fouls** Will increment by one each time it is pressed, or it will instantly "post" the next number you enter from the keypad. To blank, press Reset.
- **Vis. Fouls** -- Will increment by one each time it is pressed, or it will instantly "post" the next number you enter from the keypad. To blank, press Reset.

MSX Controller Setup

When the MSX controller is plugged in, the LCD screen on the control box will display the information from the previous game or the last information that was on the scoreboard when the controller was unplugged.

It will be necessary to "clear" the scoreboard and reset the controller for a new game.

To do this, press "FUNCTION" then "1" then "ENTER"

MSX - Reset Clock Set

The clock will display tenths and hundredths of seconds in the last minute of each period. When the clock on the scoreboard is in this mode, the lighted colons disappear, and a lighted decimal point appears between the four digits. Now the left two digits of the clock become seconds and the right two digits become tenths and hundredths. To set the time in tenths and hundredths of seconds, turn the clock off, enter the seconds and press Clock Set then enter the tenths and hundredths and press ". 00". Turn the clock on to resume play. (# Clock set # .00) i.e. (5 Clock set 6 .00) tenth of second (# Clock set ##.00) i.e. (4 Clock set 45 .00) sixteenth of second
